T Levels

Explore T Levels as a pathway to skilled employment or higher study, complemented by meaningful industry placements.

An alternative to A levels, Apprenticeships and other 16 to 19 vocational courses, T Levels are equivalent in size to three A Levels. A T Level focuses on vocational and technical skills and can help learners into skilled employment, higher study, or an Apprenticeship. T Level learners spend 80% of the course in their learning environment, gaining the skills that employers need. The other 20% is a meaningful industry placement, where they put these skills into action.

Can you offer a 45-day industry placement?

Each T Level includes an in-depth industry placement that lasts at least 45 days. Learners get valuable experience in the workplace; employers get early sight of the new talent in their industry.
