FUNDING YOUR STUDIES

If you're 16-19 and a British citizen, you won't have to pay to study, but you may need help with other essential costs like travel, books, equipment and childcare.


HERE ARE SOME OF THE SCHEMES THAT COULD HELP:

- National 16-19 bursary up to £1,200 for books, equipment, travel etc if you have a household income of £21,000 or below (See more at gov.uk/1619-bursary-fund)
- Care to Learn scheme up to £175 a week towards childcare costs while you study if you're a parent aged under 20 (See more at gov.uk/care-tolearn/overview
- > Free college meals you'll be eligible for free meals at College if you, or your parent or carer, receive benefits such as Universal Credit (see more at gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals)
- > 16+ Oyster card free travel on TFL bus routes if you're 16-18 and live in a London borough (Or half-price if you don't live in a London borough)
- > Totum Card costs £12 from NUS (nus.org.uk/en/nusextra) and gives you access to over 200 exclusive discounts for shopping, eating out etc

WE WANT EVERY STUDENT TO GET THE SUPPORT THEY NEED AT COLLEGE

so we offer a range of supported learning courses with built-in support for young people with support needs with Education Health Care plans. On our courses you will work in small groups with in-class support and can get lots of other help e.g. speech and language support, English/maths support and job coaching. Our courses include:

- Independence courses
- Vocational Taster courses
- > Preparation for Work/Vocational courses in Performing Arts, Art and Design, Catering, Horticulture, working in a café, Retail, office skills
- Moving Into Work and Volunteering courses
- Supported Internships (Hospitality, Creative Industries, Project Search Lewisham

In addition, if you are studying on one of our standard courses but feel that you need some extra help, we can provide in-class and other support for people with autism, Asperger syndrome, dyslexia, physical disabilities, visual and hearing impairments, and mental/personal care/health needs.

We will help you decide which course is best for you when you come for an interview.
